SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 151, L.D. 385, Bill, "AN ACT Providing for Field Examiner for Election Division of the Department of the Secretary of State."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting in place thereof the following new Title: 'AN ACT Providing for Municipal Coordinator for Election Division of the Department of the Secretary of State.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause of section 1 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'§ 81-A. Municipal coordinator

The Secretary of State, subject to the Personnel Law, may appoint a municipal coordinator for the Election Division of the Department of the Secretary of State, whose duties shall consist primarily of instructing and assisting municipal election officials in relation to their administration of provisions of Title 21 and shall include the training of municipal election officials prior to primary and general elections within the State.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated to the Department of the Secretary of State from the General Fund the sum of \$23,650 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
