STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Exempting Sales to the American Cancer Society from the Sales Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 36, § 1760, sub-§ 16-A, additional. Section 1760 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 16-A to read as follows:

16-A. American Cancer Society. Sales to the American Cancer Society.

FISCAL NOTE

The loss of revenue to the State is estimated to be about \$2,700 for a full year.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is reflected in the title.
