AN ACT to Increase Salaries of County Officers of Washington County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 16th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, which relates to the county officers of Washington County, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

Washington County: County commissioners, ~~\$1,800~~ \$2,000; chairman, ~~\$2,400~~ \$2,400; clerk of courts, ~~\$5,200~~ \$5,700; county attorney, \$8,500; assistant county attorney, \$4,500; county treasurer, ~~\$4,500~~ \$5,500; sheriff, ~~\$6,250~~ \$6,750; register of deeds, ~~\$5,200~~ \$5,700; judge of probate, ~~\$5,700~~ \$6,200; register of probate, ~~\$5,200~~ \$5,700;
