COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 311, L. D. 413, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Identity of Defendant in Suspension Cases under Motor Vehicle Laws."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R. S., T. 29, §2241, amended. The first paragraph of section 2241 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as last repealed and replaced by section 1 of chapter 345 of the public laws of 1971, is amended by inserting before the last sentence the following new sentence:

The date of birth and name on the notification of suspension or revocation document shall be prima facie evidence that the named person is the same person as a defendant of the same name and birthday.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to correct an error in the original bill of the allocation of the sentence to be added to section 2241.
