AN ACT Relating to Copies of Voting Lists to Political Parties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 21, § 175, amended. Section 175 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 185 of the public laws of 1971, is further amended by adding at the end the following new paragraphs:

The registrar shall furnish 2 certified copies of the voting list to each of the major political parties, without charge, no later than 45 days prior to a general election nor later than 15 days prior to a special election.

One copy each shall be given to the chairman of each of the local political parties and one copy each shall be forwarded to the chairman of each of the state political parties.

The registrar shall maintain a list of those individuals who register to vote between the period the lists are furnished to the political parties and the closing date of registration. He shall furnish a certified copy of that list, without charge, to the chairman of each of the local political parties and to the chairman of each of the state political parties within 5 days after the close of registration.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide certified copies of the voting lists to each political party without charge.
