HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to S. P. 170, L. D. 425, Bill, "AN
ACT to Amend Definitions in Ambulance Service Licensing."

Amend said Bill in the next to the last line before the
Statement of Fact (same in L.D.) by striking out the word "providing"
and inserting in place thereof the following: '~~providing~~ who routinely
provide'

Further amend said Bill in the last line before the Statement
of Fact by inserting before the period the following underlined
words 'to anyone within a geographic area upon request'
