HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to S.P. 173, L.D. 428, Bill, "AN ACT Regulating Water Well Construction and Pump Installation."

Amend said Bill in the 2nd and 3rd lines of subsection 6 of that part designated "<u>§4852.</u>" (2nd line of subsection 6 of L.D.) by striking out the underlined words and punctuation "<u>,alteration</u> <u>or repair</u>" and inserting in place thereof the following: '<u>or</u> alteration'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of subsection 2 of that part designated "<u>§4853.</u>" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'2. Private wells or pumps. Nothing in this chapter shall prevent a person from constructing a well or installing, removing or altering a pump on any property owned, controlled or leased by that person.'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to permit a property owner to construct, maintain and operate wells and pumps on his own land.
