HOUSE AMENDMENT " C " to S.P. 173, L.D. 428, Bill, "AN ACT  
Regulating Water Well Construction and Pump Installation."

Amend said Bill in the 2nd and 3rd lines of subsection 6 of  
that part designated "§4852." (2nd line of subsection 6 of L.D.)  
by striking out the underlined words and punctuation ",alteration  
or repair" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'or  
alteration'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of subsection 2 of  
that part designated "§4853." and inserting in place thereof the  
following:

'2. Private wells or pumps. Nothing in this chapter shall  
prevent a person from constructing a well or installing, removing  
or altering a pump on any property owned, controlled or leased by  
that person.'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to permit a property owner  
to construct, maintain and operate wells and pumps on his own land.
