COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 316, L.D. 434, "RESOLVE
Proposing Study of Feasibility of Establishing State Park Facilities
within Penobscot County."

Amend said Resolve by adding at the end before the Statement
of Fact the following:

' Such study shall contain, but not be limited to, the
following:

1. A projection of the future recreational needs of the
people in, and visitors to, the greater Bangor area;
2. An analysis of specific recreational activities which
could and should be satisfied by state park facilities; and
3. A definition of specific areas which could satisfy some
or all of the specific demands determined in 1 and 2 above.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to more definitely
define the study.
