IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing for a County Budget Review Board for York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 252-A, additional. Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 252-A to read as follows:

§ 252-A. York County budget review board

In York County there shall be a county budget review board which shall be composed of the chief elected official of each municipality in the county or by a person designated by him. Each municipality shall have equal representation on the board. The board shall meet to review the county budget and shall submit its recommendations to the county legislative delegation. The board shall choose its own officers who shall serve for a 2-year term.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Since the municipalities bear the expense of county government, the proposed board would allow them to study the budget and to make recommendations to the legislative delegation, which is the purpose of this bill.
