HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 321, L.D. 439, Bill, "AN ACT to Designate One Dollar of Income Tax Refunds to Political Parties."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last paragraph before the statement of fact, and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Every individual resident who has a tax liability or who is entitled to a refund under this Part, may designate that \$1 of his tax liability or refund be paid over to any specified political party, as defined in Title 21, section 1, subsection 21.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to include tax liability with refunds. This would allow more people to participate on a voluntary basis.
