HOUSE AMENDMENT "B " to H.P. 321, L.D. 439, Bill, "AN ACT
to Designate One Dollar of Income Tax Refunds to Political Parties."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting
in place thereof the following new Title: 'AN ACT to Designate
One Dollar of Income Tax Refunds or Tax Liability to Political
Parties.'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§5283."
by adding at the end before the Statement of Fact the following
new sentence:

'Every individual resident who is entitled to no refund under this
part may add \$1 to his tax liability to be paid over to any
specified political party, as defined in Title 21, section 1,
subsection 21.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to permit those who have
no income tax refund to designate \$1 of their tax liabilities to
political parties.
