**AN ACT to Designate One Dollar of Income Tax Refunds
to Political Parties.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 36, § 5283, additional. Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 5283 to read as follows:

§ 5283. Designation by resident individuals

Every individual resident, who is entitled to a refund under this Part, may designate that \$1 of the refund be paid over to any specified political party, as defined in Title 21, section 1, subsection 21.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit an individual who is entitled to an income tax refund to designate that \$1 of the refund be paid over to a political party.
