STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Motor Vehicle Licenses for Persons on Active Duty in the Armed Forces.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 535, amended. The first sentence of section 535 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

On application to the Secretary of State, any person who is serving **on active duty** in the Armed Forces of the United States in time of war or national emergency and who is otherwise qualified to operate a motor vehicle in this State shall receive a license without the requirement of the payment of any fee.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This would provide for the issuance of a no-fee license to a member of the Armed Forces at any time, regardless of war or national emergency.
