HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to H. P. 346, L. D. 461, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to Boundaries of Ocean Park Game and Bird Sanctuary."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the underlined paragraph  
after the amending clause and before the Statement of Fact and  
inserting in place thereof the following:

'Ocean Park Game and Bird Sanctuary: The following described  
territory situated in the Town of Old Orchard Beach, in the County  
of York: Beginning at a point on the easterly side of Fresh Water  
Cove Brook, so called, where the same intersects the Boston and Maine  
Railroad right-of-way; thence southerly along said brook to its  
mouth where it joins the Goose Fare Brook; thence southeasterly along  
said Goose Fare Brook to its mouth; thence easterly and parallel  
with the Atlantic Ocean and 50 feet in front of all bulkheads and  
houses fronting on the beach to the easterly side of Tunis Avenue;  
thence northwesterly along said avenue to the Boston and Maine  
Railroad right-of-way; thence by said Boston and Maine right-of-way  
to point of beginning.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment is to exclude the Country Club's property from  
the bill as the Fresh Water Cove Brook is the dividing line between  
their property and the N. E. Baptist Council's.
