AN ACT Relating to Boundaries of Ocean Park Game and Bird Sanctuary.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2101, amended. The 22nd paragraph of section 2101 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, under the caption Ocean Park Game and Bird Sanctuary, as amended by section 17 of chapter 425 of the public laws of 1969, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Ocean Park Game and Bird Sanctuary: The following described territory situated in the Town of Old Orchard Beach, in the County of York:

Beginning at a point on the easterly side of Goose Fare Brook where the same intersects the Boston and Maine Railroad right-of-way; thence south-easterly along said brook to its mouth, thence at right angles and easterly and parallel with the Atlantic Ocean and 50 feet in front of all bulkheads and houses fronting on the beach to the easterly side of Tunis Avenue, thence northwesterly along said avenue to the Boston and Maine Railroad right-of-way, thence by said Boston and Maine right-of-way to point of beginning.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to enlarge the boundaries of the Ocean Park Game and Bird Sanctuary.
