COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 347, L.D. 462, Bill,
"AN ACT Providing for Voluntary Continuance of Residence at
Juvenile Institutions and the Military and Naval Children's
Home for Program Completion Beyond the Age of 18 Years."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the Title the words
"Juvenile Institutions and"

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 2nd line(same in LD)
of the 2nd paragraph of the emergency preamble the words and punctuation
"Boys Training Center, Stevens School or"

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the 4th
paragraph of the emergency preamble.

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the first line
of the 5th paragraph (same in L.D.) the word "institutions" and
inserting in place thereof the following: 'institution'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend said Bill by striking out at the beginning of
the first line of section 2 the underlined abbreviation and figure
"Sec. 2."

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that this
emergency legislation apply only to the Military and/Naval Children's
Home residents, in which the emergency actually exists.
