HOUSE AMENDMENT" A " to H.P. 348, L.D. 463, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Authorization of Nongeographic School Administrative Units at Correctional Institutions."

Amend said Bill by striking out the last 2 words "wherever applicable" of the first paragraph of that part designated " §529." and inserting in place thereof the following: 'and shall be subject to the approval standards of the Department of Educational and Cultural Services'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 3rd and 4th lines from the end, (3rd line from the end in L.D.) before the Statement of Fact, the following underlined words: "insofar as possible, as shall be determined by the State Board of Education" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'except that in valuation of the unit the average valuation for the State shall be used. Such payments from General Purpose Aid shall be made directly to the Bureau of Corrections'

Statement of Fact

Legislation of this nature would allow the Bureau of Corrections to be eligible to receive federal assistance to assist in educational programs for both adults and juvenile institutions.
