AN ACT Relating to Legislation Affecting Penobscot Tribe of Indians.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 22, § 4793, additional. Title 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 4793, to read as follows:

§ 4793. Legislation

No legislation directly affecting the Penobscot Tribe of Indians shall be introduced into the Legislature without first being submitted to the governor and council of the Penobscot Tribe of Indians for their approval.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to assure that the Penobscot Tribe of Indians will be better informed as to any bills introduced into the Legislature affecting them.
