AN ACT Relating to Minimum Wages for Students.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 26, § 664, amended. The last paragraph of section 664 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 5 of chapter 466 of the public laws of 1967, and as amended by section 43 of chapter 504 of the public laws of 1969, is further amended by adding a new sentence at the end to read as follows:

In computing the minimum wage under this paragraph, tips received by such an employee shall be excluded.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Students may be paid at a rate of 75% of the applicable minimum wage. The purpose of this bill is to exclude tips received by such student in computing the minimum wage.
