# STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Relating to Liquor Licensee Records.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 28, § 351, amended. The last sentence of the first paragraph of section 351 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

All such records shall be open to the commission  $\Theta r$ , its representative or representatives of the Bureau of Liquor Enforcement of the Department of Public Safety at any time and the commission  $\Theta r$ , its representatives or representatives of said Bureau of Liquor Enforcement shall have the right to make copies thereof which may be used as evidence of violation of this section.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 28, § 351, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 351 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

No licensee shall refuse the commission or, its representatives or representatives of said Bureau of Liquor Enforcement the right at any time completely to inspect the entire licensed premises or to audit the books and records of the licensee.

### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to make licensee records available to liquor enforcement officials who are now located within the Department of Public Safety.
