AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Sale of Liquor in Violation of Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 1051, amended. The last sentence of section 1051 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Whoever violates any of the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$500, and costs, and in addition thereto by imprisonment for not less than 2 months nor more than 6 months ~~and in default of payment of fine and costs, by imprisonment for 6 months additional.~~

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to remove the unconstitutional penalty provision.
