COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 359, L. D. 474, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Criminal Contempt for Failure to Pay Alimony and Support of Children."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 7th line (same in L. D.) the underlined words "the body of"

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the underlined word and punctuation "offense," in the 21st line (18th line in L. D.) the underlined words 'up to'; and by inserting after the underlined word and punctuation "offense," in the 22nd line (19th in L. D.) the underlined words 'up to'; and by inserting after the underlined word and punctuation "offense," in the 23rd line (20th in L. D.) the underlined words 'up to'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to delete the provision for an execution against the body of any party charged with payment of support or alimony and to provide that the sentences prescribed for first, 2nd and subsequent offenses be maximum sentences.
