COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 363, L.D. 478, Bill, "AN ACT Changing the Name of the Maine Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Academy."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 3 and before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 4. R. S., T. 25, § 2901, amended. Section 2901 of Title 25 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 496 of the public laws of 1971, and as amended by section 14 of chapter 592 of the public laws of 1971, is further amended to read as follows:

§ 2901. Department; commissioner

There is hereby created and established the Department of Public Safety to coordinate and efficiently manage the law enforcement responsibilities of the State of Maine, to consist of the Commissioner of Public Safety, who shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Council to serve a term coterminous with that of the Governor, subject to removal for cause by the Governor and Council and the following as heretofore created and established: The Department of the State Police, the Enforcement Division of the State Liquor Commission, the state representatives and employees of the Vehicle Equipment Safety Commission, the Division of State Fire Prevention of the
