STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Exempting Hearing Aids from the Sales Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 36, § 1760, sub-§ 5-A, additional. Section 1760 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 5-A to read as follows:

5-A. Hearing Aids. Sales of hearing aids.

FISCAL NOTE

It is estimated that this Act will result in a loss of revenue to the State of about \$5,500 per year.
