AN ACT Relating to Display of Vehicle Headlamps.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 1368, amended. Section 1368 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by inserting after the first paragraph a new paragraph to read as follows:

No vehicles, other than ambulances, fire department, police department and highway maintenance vehicles, shall be equipped with a device which provides for the alternate flashing of the vehicle's headlamps.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to regulate the operation of vehicles with flashing headlamps.
