COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 366, L.D. 481, Resolve,  
Designating Lewiston-Auburn Bridge as "Louis Jalbert Bridge."

Amend said Resolve by inserting in the title before the second  
word "Bridge" the word 'Memorial'

Further amend said Resolve by striking out everything  
after the words "be named the" in the 7th line (6th line of  
L.D.) before the statement of fact, and inserting in place  
thereof the following:

' "Louis Jalbert Memorial Bridge," and that an appropriate  
plaque designating the name of the bridge may be erected and  
maintained at no expense to the State and subject to the  
approval of the Department of Transportation.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to add the word "Memorial"  
and to provide that there be no expense to the State.
