RESOLVE, Designating Lewiston-Auburn Bridge as "Louis Jalbert Bridge."

Louis Jalbert Bridge; designated. Resolved: In recognition of the outstanding and unselfish service of Louis Jalbert to the Lewiston-Auburn area, the County of Androscoggin and the State of Maine that the bridge, constructed across the Androscoggin River between the Cities of Auburn and Lewiston and authorized by chapter 226 of the private and special laws of 1967 be named the "Louis Jalbert Bridge," and that an appropriate plaque designating the name of the bridge be erected and maintained by the Department of Transportation at such location as the Department of Transportation shall select.
