**AN ACT Providing a Full-time Office in the Town of Skowhegan for
Registration and Licenses for Operation of Motor Vehicles.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Motor vehicle registration office; Skowhegan. The Secretary of State shall maintain a full-time office at Skowhegan to carry out his duties relating to applications for registration of and licenses for the operation of motor vehicles.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Highway Fund to the Secretary of State, Motor Vehicle Division, the sum of \$35,045 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
