IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Officials of Waldo County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 15th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes which relates to Waldo County, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

Waldo County: County commissioners, \$7,200 \$1,500; clerk of courts, \$6,300 \$6,930; county attorney, \$8,000; county treasurer, \$2,100; sheriff, \$6,200 \$7,040; register of deeds, \$5,500 \$6,050; judge of probate, \$5,500 \$6,050; register of probate, \$5,500 \$6,050;

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to allow for increases due to higher costs of living and to bring salaries more into line with existing conditions.
