STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Payments to Waldo County Law Library.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 27, § 224, amended. The 15th paragraph of section 224 of Title 27 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by chapter 255 of the public laws of 1971, is amended to read as follows:

Waldo, \$1,500 \$3,500 for the year 1971 and \$1,500 for the year 1972;

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase payments to the Waldo County Law Library from \$1,500 to \$3,500 per year.
