IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT to Reduce Fees for Junkyards and Auto Graveyards.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2455, sub-§ 1, amended. Subsection 1 of section 2455 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as last repealed and replaced by section 3 of chapter 481 of the public laws of 1965, and as amended by chapter 260 of the public laws of 1971, is further amended to read as follows:

1. **More than 100 feet from highway.** ~~Fifty~~ Ten dollars for each permit for an automobile graveyard or junkyard located more than 100 feet from any highway, plus the cost of posting and publishing said notice.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this Act to return the permit fee for small yards to a reasonable amount. Because of the service they do for communities, small yards should be encouraged.
