HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 372, L.D. 501, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Real Estate Brokers' Trust Accounts."

Amend said Bill in the 5th line (4th line in L.D.) by inserting after the word "broker" the following underlined words, figures and punctuation:

', except for an amount necessary to maintain said accounts not to exceed \$25,'

This amendment allows a broker to leave enough of his own money in his trust account to cover service charges and other miscellaneous charges to his trust account.
