# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Relating to Real Estate Brokers' Trust Accounts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 32, § 4004-A, amended. The 3rd sentence of section 4004-A of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 3 of chapter 468 of the public laws of 1971, is amended to read as follows:

The broker shall withdraw from said accounts all commissions and fees due him within a reasonable time 15 days after they are earned, but not until, consummation or termination of the transaction, when the broker shall make a full accounting thereof to his principal.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The present statute requires that commissions and fees shall be withdrawn within a reasonable time. The intent of this proposed legislation is to further clarify a reasonable time.
