STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Per Diem Compensation for Members of the Real Estate Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 32, § 4052, amended. Section 4052 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 359 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

§ 4052. Compensation

Each member of the commission shall receive as full compensation for each day actually spent on the work of said commission the sum of \$25 \$35 and his actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of duties pertaining to his office.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this bill is to increase per diem compensation for Real Estate Commission members.
