AN ACT Regulating the Use of Power Boats on Trafton Lake, Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 38, § 251, additional. Title 38 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 251 to read as follows:

§ 251. Trafton Lake, Aroostook County

No person, except officers empowered to enforce this subchapter, shall operate a motorboat having more than 7 horsepower on Trafton Lake, Town of Limestone, Aroostook County.
