STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Redefine the Legal Standard of Time for Hauling of Lobster Traps.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 12, § 4458, sub-§ 1, amended. Subsection 1 of section 4458 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- 1. Definition of sunset and sunrise. For the purpose of this section sunset and sunrise is that time given for sunset or sunrise in the Maine Farmer's Almanae as computed and established for Augusta, Maine, by the Nautical Almanac Office of the United States Naval Observatory for the particular day involved converted to the legal standard of time in force in this State on that day.
