SEVENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Providing for Purchase of Copies of History of Livermore.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

History of Livermore; purchase of. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,000 for the State to purchase 100 copies of the book entitled "A History of Livermore" by Reginald H. Sturtevant, said books to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the State Librarian.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It has been the practice of the Legislature to encourage historical books, which help to preserve the history of Maine, by purchasing copies for distribution to the young people of Maine.
