AN ACT Prohibiting the Hunting of Bear with Dogs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2355-D, additional. Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2355-D to read as follows:

§ 2355-D. Hunting bear with dogs prohibited

It shall be unlawful for any person or persons hunting together, to use dogs for the purpose of hunting bear.

STATEMENT OF FACT
