SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 193, L.D. 538, RESOLVE, to Locate the Public Lot in Township 2, Range 6 W.B.K.P., Franklin County.

Amend said Resolve by striking out in the last 2 lines before the Statement of Fact the following: ", insure that the public lot contains areas suitable for waterfront recreation," and inserting in place thereof the following: 'include, but shall not be limited to, appropriate consideration of the following criteria:

1. Contiguosness to other public lands;
2. Public recreation needs;
3. Accessibility to roads, highways and other transportation;
4. Proximity to centers of population;
5. Needs of state agencies;
6. Scenic quality;
7. Value as to minerals;
8. Value as to timber;
9. The preservation of significant natural, recreational and historic resources, including wildlife habitat and other areas critical to the ecology of the State;
10. The provisions of any applicable comprehensive or long-range management plan for use of public lands; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the sum of \$10,535 be appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Forestry Department to carry out the purposes of this resolve. This appropriation shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of the amendment is to direct the Forest Commissioner to set up criteria for location of the public let and to add an appropriation to the resolve.
