**AN ACT Relating to Payments to the Nathan and Henry B. Cleaves Law
Library of the Cumberland Bar Association.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 27, § 224, amended. The 4th paragraph of section 224 of Title 27 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by chapter 255 of the public laws of 1971, is amended to read as follows:

Cumberland, ~~\$5,000~~ \$7,000 which shall be paid to the treasurer of the Cumberland Bar Association for the Nathan and Henry B. Cleaves Law Library;

STATEMENT OF FACT

The last increase in the appropriation for the Cleaves Law Library was in 1971 when the amount was increased from \$3,000 to \$5,000. The expenses of the library have continued to increase due in great part to increased usage by government personnel. Because of the increased cost of books, an adjustment must be made in the appropriation in order to keep the library collection up to date.
