**AN ACT Increasing Salary of Superior Court Messenger of
Cumberland County.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 4, §113, amended. Section 113 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

§ 113. Messenger of Cumberland County

The superior court messenger of Cumberland County shall be appointed by the senior resident Superior Court Justice and shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$7,200~~ \$7,560 in full compensation for service and attendance.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the salary of the superior court messenger of Cumberland County from \$7,200 to \$7,560.
