AN ACT Requiring Liquor Inspectors to Wear Uniforms While on Duty.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 55, sub-§ 14, amended. Subsection 14 of section 55 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new paragraph to read as follows:

When on duty to enforce the laws relating to alcoholic beverages or any other duties established by statute, liquor inspectors shall be in uniform.

STATEMENT OF FACT
