AN ACT Increasing Bond of Register of Probate in Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 18, § 251, amended. The 3rd sentence of section 251 of Title 18 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

All registers, before acting, shall give bond to the treasurer of their county with sufficient sureties in the sum of \$2,500, **except that this sum shall be \$10,000 for Cumberland County.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the personal bond limitation. The present \$2,500 minimum requirement is grossly insufficient to cover the financial transactions involved in this office in Cumberland County.
