**AN ACT Relating to Exemption of Fire Trucks from Motor Vehicle
Inspection.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 2122, amended. The first sentence of the 6th paragraph of section 2122 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

This section shall not apply to farm tractors or fire trucks which are manufactured as such. For purposes of this section a fire truck is defined as a fire department vehicle which has fire fighting equipment built into or onto the vehicle as an integral part of its construction, such as pump, tank or ladder trucks.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to exclude fire trucks, as defined, from the motor vehicle inspection requirements.
