AN ACT Relating to Charges to Municipalities by Counties for Costs of
Food Stamp Programs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1971, c. 571, § 2, amended. The last paragraph of section 2 of chapter 571 of the public laws of 1971 is amended to read as follows:

For the year 1973 and thereafter counties desiring food stamp or donated food programs may fund the programs by including any necessary amounts in their budget, but will **only charge municipalities which elect to participate in said programs for costs actually incurred by such municipalities.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide that municipalities who participate in food programs shall be charged by their counties for costs actually incurred by such municipalities.
