COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" A" to H.P. 433, L.D. 582, Bill, "An ACT Relating to Credit for Confinement within County Jail Prior to Sentencing."

Amend said bill by inserting in the 7th line after the amending clause (6th line of L.D.) after the underlined word "sentence" the following underlined words and punctuation: ',pending appeal,'

Further amend said bill by inserting at the end, before the statement of fact, the following underlined paragraph:

'If any such person shall be committed to jail or other place of detention to await transportation to the place at which his sentence is to be served, his sentence shall commence to run from the date on which he is received at such jail or other place of detention.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to include as a time period for which credit should be allowed against the term of a sentence, the time that a person may spend in a county jail pending an appeal on his conviction and sentence and the time that a person may spend in a county jail awaiting transportation to the place at which his sentence is to be served.
