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**AN ACT Relating to Permits to Engage in Business of Propagating Wild  
Animals or Wild Rabbits.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 12, § 2106, amended.** The first sentence of section 2106 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The commissioner may issue permits to any person, firm or corporation to engage in the business of propagating game or wild animals or wild rabbits on islands surrounded by open salt water or on any designated area all year under such regulations as he shall establish.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game to permit the propagation of wild animals or rabbits on any designated area.
