AN ACT Relating to Payments of Accounts and Claims Against the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 5, § 125, amended. Section 125 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph at the end to read as follows:

The Treasurer of the State of Maine shall not pay out any funds for an account or claim against the State unless such account or claim is itemized and such account or claim is declared to be a public record. Any violation of this section shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or by both.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is reflected in the title to bring it in line with county and municipal treasurers.
