STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Provide Funds for the Development of an Airport in the Rumford-Mexico Area.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$82,500 and the Department of Transportation is authorized and empowered to expend said funds for the purpose of developing an airport in the Rumford-Mexico area.
- Sec. 2. Appropriation shall not lapse. The appropriation provided by this Act shall not lapse but shall remain in a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this Act have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide funds for the State's share of the cost of developing an airport with a 3,200-foot runway in the Rumford-Mexico area. There is \$25,000 available from a previously approved bond issue which makes up the remainder of the State's share. It is anticipated that the Federal Aviation Administration will participate to the extent of 50% of the cost of the facility with the remaining 25% of the total funds provided locally. The total estimated cost of the facility is \$430,000.
